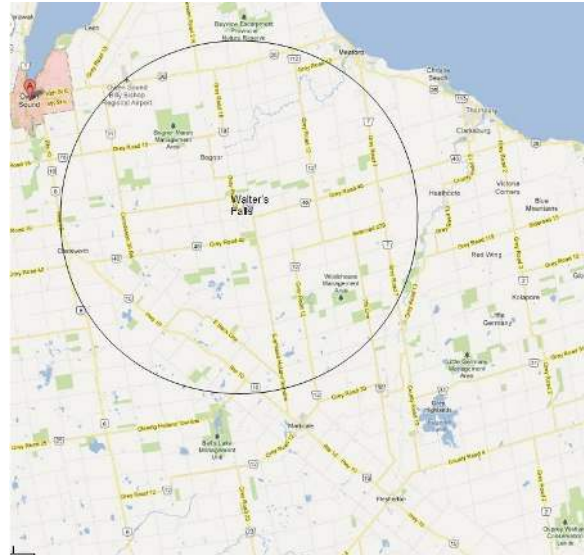


GUEST ARTIST SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Boundary

Artists who participate in the Walters Falls Group of Artists' (WFGA) Show must live approximately 15 kilometres of Walter's Falls. This radius includes the communities of Chatsworth, Holland Centre and Berkeley as well as Walter's Falls, Bognor, and Rocklyn.



Guest Artist Guidelines

- Participants should reside in the boundary area as described above.
- Participants must submit actual (not digital) sample of their work for review and assessment by the WFGA. It is suggested that not less than three (3) and not more than five (5) works be included in the submission.
- If accepted for participation, the guest artist must pay a participation fee (as established by WFGA) and agree to some participation conditions related to the Show (volunteer roles, dates and times for delivery of work, submission of biographical information and digital images for inclusion on the brochure, website, and other online and/or promotional material).
- A guest artist may apply for participation in subsequent years, but should be aware that inclusion in one year does not mean automatic inclusion in subsequent years. WFGA members have decision-making prerogative regarding guest artist participation.
- Prospective guest artists are encouraged to submit a letter of intent by the end of November following the August Show for the next year's Show. Send letters of intent to one of permanent members for forwarding, or to Jo Ann Sauks, 497080 Concession 6, South Bognor, ON NOH 1E0.

Full-time Membership

- Prospective members must have been a WFGA guest artist for at least two (2) previous WFGA Shows.
- Prospective members may apply on their own initiative or be nominated by WFGA members.
- The WFGA original number of 17 full-time members should not be exceeded.
- The final decision to accept or reject a prospective new member rests with the WFGA members.
- Annual membership dues shall be established by the WFGA.
